

Scorekeeper FAQ

Q. Why do we need to submit a game summary?

A. It is used for several things, including pitcher eligibility, standings for 10u and above, and tracking who has pitched for fair distribution of pitchers in future seasons.

Q. Who submits the game summary?

A. The home scorekeeper or manager. For 12U and 14U interleague games see the next question.

Q. Who submits game summary forms for interleague (against other leagues) games in 12U and 14U?

A. The 12U/14U MVLAGE team is responsible for the game summary form whether they are the home or visiting team in interleague play.

Q. How do I submit the game summary?

A. There is a league communications box inside the snack shack that is usually on a table outside the snack shack when it is open. Put it in the scorekeeper folder in there.

Q. Is there an electronic way to submit the game summary?

A. Scanning it and emailing it to scores@mvlags.org is acceptable if you can't make it to the snack shack, but please submit the paper one the next time you are at Stevenson.

Q. Why keep score at 8U if there are no standings kept?

A. The umpire needs help keeping track of batting order, strike and ball counts, and pitchers. The league also needs to have a record of who pitched in each game and for how many innings. The manager and/or coaches can also use the scorebook as a reference to know what needs to be worked on at practice.

8U Scorekeeper responsibilities-

- Make sure game summary is filled out, defensive plan, and batting order are put in the scorekeeper folder of the communications box for each game
- Keep track of batting order, strikes, balls, and outs to assist the umpire
- Track balls after the count is reset for coach pitch (use / for player pitch, then \ for coach pitch in the balls squares in the scorebook)
- Track pitchers and the innings each pitched on game summary form for player agent to help balance teams in the future.
- Keep track of statistics for the manager and/or coach to refer to for ideas on what to work on during practice.
- Consider tracking statistics in a tool like Lineupmanager3.1 to provide season long statistics for the coaching staff.

10U Scorekeeper responsibilities-

- Make sure game summary is filled out and put in the scorekeeper of the communications box for each game
- Keep track of batting order, strikes, balls, outs, and score to assist the umpire
- Track balls after the count is reset for coach pitch (use / for player pitch, then \ for coach pitch in the balls squares in the scorebook) FYI - 4th ball on the batter with bases loaded, the coach comes in to pitch.
- Track pitchers and the outs each pitched on game summary form for player agent to help balance teams in the future.
- Keep track of statistics for the manager and/or coach to refer to for ideas on what to work on during practice.
- Consider tracking statistics in a tool like Lineupmanager3.1 to provide season long statistics for the coaching staff.

12U+ Scorekeeper responsibilities-

- Make sure game summary is filled out and put in the scorekeeper of the communications box for each game
- Keep track of batting order, strikes, balls, outs, and score to assist the umpire
- Track pitchers and the outs each pitched on game summary form for player agent to help balance teams in the future.
- Keep track of statistics for the manager and/or coach to refer to for ideas on what to work on during practice.
- Consider tracking statistics in a tool like Lineupmanager3.1 to provide season long statistics for the coaching staff.
